About the role/family: SENNIES is excited to support a wonderful family of 4 find a part time Sennie to support the mother with the care of their 2 adorable children! B3 does not attend nursery so we are looking for a Sennie who can divide and conquer with the mother to provide quality care for both boys!

About the child/children: B3 is a sensitive, smart, curious and imaginative little boy, who loves going to the park to play football, going to the playground in good weather, being on the swing, playing with sand, water toys, painting, lego and playing with cars. B3 used to watch some cartoons but found it over stimulating so this activity has stopped.

B3 doesn't attend nursery as the environment and parent separation would be too overwhelming. Whilst B3 does not have an official SEN diagnosis, the family are cognisant of some potentially autistic characteristics based on his sensory profile. B3 is verbal and doesn't like loud or sudden noises or other strong sensations such as a strong wind. He is very visual and can get worried/ scared by images, e.g. dinosaurs or monsters. He also feels emotions very strongly and can at times become very anxious or have very big feelings. He is attached to his mother and takes longer to warm up to new people than a typically developing 3 year old. We hope to find a Sennie who can build a loving and trusting bond with B3, which will provide time and space for the mother to spend 1:1 time with both boys. The family are currently working on a developmental attachment approach and avoiding all form of punishment e.g. naughty step. They instead focus on positive reinforcement and would like their Sennie to do the same.

B9 Months is a sweet and loving baby who will mostly be cared for by the Mother, however, the selected Sennie should feel comfortable and confident caring for both boys from time to time.

- A SEN nanny / SEN nursery worker / SEN Teaching Assistant / SEN 1:1 looking for part time work in the daytime
- Someone who has a sibling with SEN and played an active role in their care
- A graduate or Student studying a childcare or SEN related course e.g Psychology
- Someone patient, creative, fun and caring with a lot of energy. Someone who can take charge in a caring way.
