He also enjoys time on the trampoline and appreciates moments of quiet, making it very clear when he wants to be left alone. Despite his physical challenges, B10 remains incredibly cheerful and is a joy to be around.

The family is looking for a Sennie who can provide the right balance of care, support, and encouragement, helping B10 with his daily routines while also engaging him in his favourite activities. The role will require assistance in the mornings before school and then again after school, ensuring that B10 is well-prepared for his day and supported in the afternoons. Additionally, the Sennie will play a crucial role in helping B10 develop danger awareness, teaching him to recognise and respond to potential hazards in a safe and understanding manner. The ideal candidate will be patient, attentive, and capable of fostering a safe and positive environment where B10 can continue to thrive.
