About the child/children: G5 is a bright, engaging and energetic girl who is interested in the world around her. She particularly enjoys the outdoors and nature, as well as arts and crafts. She is sporty, has a lot of energy and responds well to people who can match her energy levels and who like to come up with fun games and engage in creative play.

Due to her age and/or lack or severity of any potential conditions, G5 has not yet had a confirmed diagnosis. She does however display challenging behaviours which suggest possible ADD/ADHD, ODD and/or low level Autism. It is important that the Sennie is able to build a bond with her during valuable one-on-one time, and provide positive reinforcement and validation. It's important the Sennie has the emotional intelligence to have authority without being overbearing or confrontational, and has a calm, gentle approach. G5 is most regulated when she has one on one attention, feels she is having her needs met, is being heard, and also when she doesn't feel she is being rushed. She often needs time to build up to a transition from one activity to the next.

G5 displays some sensory seeking tendencies such as thumb sucking and feeling certain fabrics/materials.

We are seeking an energetic, compassionate and creative individual to provide essential support to a loving family of four. The Sennie's role will mainly involve providing G5 with quality one-on-one time after school to ensure a smooth wind down period and transition from day time to bed time, to free up her parents to assist her older sister with her homework and other household duties. The Sennie will be responsible for picking her up from school, bringing her home and overseeing the evening routine - this includes dinner (prepared by mum - no cooking involved), bath and homework, until her bedtime at 8pm. This role requires no household tasks. G8 may occasionally want to join in activities with G5 but the Sennie will primarily be responsible for supporting G5.

Sensory and Safety Checklist: The family have identified that G5:

 Can resist instructions or requests from adults; Is tactile and sometimes needs to be reminded about boundaries and personal space; Responds well to human interaction and creative play and is not lacking in empathy

Main duties / responsibilities:

- Incorporate strategies provided to the family by their educational psychologist into fun and engaging after-school activities
- Homework support for G5
- Form a bond and offer 1:1 emotional support for G5
- Support with mealtimes, and G5's bath and bedtime routine
