Therefore, as his Sennie, you will have the rewarding task of striking a balance between regular movement and rest, catering to his unique needs. His fine motor skills are an area for development, especially when it comes to activities like drawing and painting, so these are not activities he likes to engage in for long periods of time. He thrives in structured and routine environments, using visual aids to plan ahead and manage anxiety. While he's adept at communication, he requires some extra time to process information.

Your role will encompass fostering B6's development in various aspects, including fine motor skills, confidence-building, regular physical activity, emotional awareness, and organisational skills. Structured yet flexible planning will be key, with a focus on maintaining a consistent routine while allowing for adaptability when needed.
