**About the child/children:** B15 loves listening to music, playing on his iPad, eating, and swimming. His iPad is a source of entertainment and learning, offering various games and educational apps that he enjoys. Swimming is one of his favourite physical activities, providing both fun and a sense of calm. B15 has a vibrant personality and numerous interests that keep him engaged and happy. The family will be visiting London with B15's siblings and will be staying near Regents Park.

The family aims to balance engaging in activities together while allowing B15 to pursue independent activities. They will support the Sennie in building a bond with B15 initially. B15 and the Sennie will join the family on some outings, and the Sennie will also need to plan independent activities for B15. A stroller will be available for B15 to use on outings if he gets tired. B15 sometimes becomes emotionally dysregulated, stims, and hits his head, and occasionally runs. He also sometimes regurgitates his food and plays with it, for which the family often provides chewing gum to reduce this behaviour.

**Main duties / responsibilities:**

- Supporting with toileting Ensuring B15 has healthy food throughout the day
- Support when meeting new people
- B15 sometimes puts things in his mouth he shouldn't, so the Sennie will be required to monitor this
- B15 finds transitions and meeting new people challenging and the Sennie will need to build a bond with him and the family in the beginning to gain his trust
- Planning local, engaging activities for B15
