About the child/children: B10 is a happy and friendly boy who finds delight in playing football, watching it on TV, engaging in discussions about it, and attending live matches. Besides football, he also finds joy in watching a variety of other TV programmes. Swimming, role-playing games, and playing video games with his brother or a friend are among his other favourite activities. The family hopes that a Sennie will encourage B10 to spend more time outside the house, to become more physically active, and facilitate playdates. Since B10 can easily become distracted and lose focus, therefore, the Sennie will need to teach him self-awareness. Furthermore, the Sennie will assist B10 in establishing a structured routine, implementing strategies and therapies, organising physical activities, and creating visual aids and timetables. The family is seeking a genuine, caring, and patient Sennie who can help B10 develop conversation skills and personal care understanding.

At present B10 is presenting with ADHD, ASD, and receives Speech and Language support. He attends an SEN school. B10 is not physically aggressive or challenging, but he can be avoidant of demands. B10 tends to absorb information better when not making direct eye contact with the speaker. He finds crowded areas very difficult, can get easily distracted by sounds and noises, and has difficulties with gross motor skills like running and climbing. B10's relationship with his older sibling (B13) is ok but not going out is causing strain between them as B13 is getting frustrated, therefore, it is important for the family that the Sennie can provide support to B10 while accompanying him and his older sibling outside.

- Encourage B10 to be more physically active
- Create structured routines
- Teach B10 to be more self-aware
- Assist in creating visual aids
- Conduct play dates
- Organise fun/educational activities for B10 in the family home and outdoors.
