About the role/family: *SENNIES* is excited to support a returning client find additional support for Fridays and weekends each week. We are seeking a PA / Buddy for B17, who has quad athetoid Cerebral Palsy. The family is looking for someone with a can-do attitude, who is energetic and can encourage B17 to spend more time outside and engage in external activities where possible. The role involves assisting B17 with intimate personal care tasks. The ideal candidate should have childcare or young adult care experience with great references and special needs experience (cerebral palsy experience is an advantage).

They describe their household as a relaxed and friendly atmosphere with lots of coming and going (4 children in total, G21, B19, B17 & B15, however this role is only to support B17). They are academically ambitious, but also keen to prioritise happiness and quality of life.

About the child/children: B17 is a bright young man with a great sense of humour who enjoys watching music videos, compiling Spotify playlists, watching movies, and using Instagram and TikTok (someone who is clued-up on technology and social media to ensure he is enjoying the internet safely would be ideal). He has quad athetoid cerebral palsy, with little functional control over his body, meaning he is a full-time wheelchair user. Whilst B17 is able to take some food orally, he is largely fed a blended food diet through his tube, therefore the Sennie must be comfortable and confident in managing this task.

The candidate will be required to act as a role model, encourage independence and support independent learning, and use every experience as an opportunity to learn and explore. B17 has a couple of hours of homework to complete most weekends so patience and motivating skills will come in handy.

Although B17 is non-verbal, he communicates well using an eye gaze device and/or a low-tech communication system and currently attends mainstream school. IT competence would be an advantage to best support him.
